		aviation legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan (for certificates of pilots, remote

p. 7	For the next (subsequent) recognition of aviation personnel license, the applicant shall submit the following documents to the authorized organization: (via eotinish.kz portal):	 an application for recognition of aviation personnel license issued by a foreign state in the form according to <u>Appendix 2</u> to these Rules; a copy of the aviation personnel license (all pages with entries); copy of the medical certificate of the relevant class (for certificates of pilots, external pilots, flight crew members other than pilots); copy of the flight or simulator check certificate for the last 12 months for the requested qualification mark for the type of aircraft (for certificates of pilots, external pilots and flight crew members other than pilots); copies of individual logbook pages (Logbook) for the previous 12 months with proof of at least 6 months' experience in maintenance of the relevant aircraft type (for aircraft maintenance personnel).



p. 8	- within 5 working days, the authorized organization shall review the submitted documents and, if the applicant provides		
	a complete set of documents specified in paragraphs 6 or 7 of these Rules, shall send a request to the aviation authorities		
	of the foreign state or be guided by the information published on their official website to confirm the validity of the		
	aviation personnel license, qualification and special marks, medical certificate, and other permits issued by this state. The		
	confirmation is valid for 2 working days.		
- after confirmation of the validity of aviation personnel license, qualification and special marks, medical cert			
other permits issued by a foreign state, the authorized organization shall, within 2 working days, issue a Certifica			
	by a foreign state in the form according to Annex 1 to these Rules, or issue a reasoned refusal to recognize the average personnel license of a foreign state on the grounds specified in paragraph 20 of these Rules.		
	- if the fact of incompleteness of submitted documents or lack of information required for the procedure of recognition of		
	a foreign aviation personnel license is established, the authorized organization shall send a notification to the applicant		
	on the need to provide missing documents or information stipulated in paragraphs 6 or 7 of these Rules and the deadline		
	for their provision.		
	- the deadline for submission of documents or information specified in the notification shall be 5 working days from the		
	date of the notification.		
	- if the applicant fails to submit the documents or information specified in the notice within 5 working days from the date		
	of receipt, the authorized organization shall return the documents to the applicant and terminate their consideration.		
p. 9	The certificate shall be filled out in the official language of ICAO - English.		
p. 10	The certificate shall be issued to the applicant or his/her representative by power of attorney.		
p. 11	Issued Certificates shall be registered in the Register of the authorized organization.
